How did you use the Core Mission grant? Please describe in detail what the funds were spent on?

Greyston is grateful to Impact100 Westchester for the 2020 Core Mission grant award.

A portion of the grant has helped support a new occupational skills training, Environmental Technician. This type of training was developed in response to local employers seeking facility maintenance workers who are trained to effectively sanitize workspaces and is considered an essential worker position.

In addition, this award has helped fund the unanticipated expenses that are necessary to provide the skills training courses on-site at our facility within NYS mandated regulations. With your support, Greyston has been able to the required social distancing and regular sanitization of all surfaces throughout the on-site Yonkers facility to ensure the highest quality of safety for the clients and staff.

What need did the Core Mission grant meet? Who benefitted from this grant?

The Core Mission grant helped cover the anticipated and the unanticipated costs due to COVID, ensuring that the services continue to be provided with the least amount of disruption during the pandemic. Our clients need for comprehensive employment services remained during the pandemic. In fact, the economic impact of the pandemic increased the need for Greyston’s Workforce Development. The low skilled workers were the first furloughed or fired. Our clients and the community benefited. Greyston was also very fortunate that no staff was furloughed due to COVID.

What impact did these funds have on your clients and/or on your organization?

This grant has helped Greyston continue serving our clients, while limiting the disruption due to COVID. Since receiving this award in June, 116 clients have graduated the Workforce Development program and 36 people have secured permanent positions.
